

Connect ScanLister to your Amazon account by following these steps:


## Step 1

On ScanLister, go to **Settings** then **Account**.



## Step 2

Select your Amazon Marketplace from the dropdown menu.



### Step 3

Then select “click here to register”.



### Step 4

Fill out your Amazon email and password







On ScanLister, go to settings and paste in the Seller ID and MWS Auth Token. You do not need to fill out the Access Key and Secret Key.
